#### ***QDC Board Gives Final OK***

The Quonset Development Corporation (QDC) Board unanimously approved plans to reconfigure Davisville Road in order to route traffic into and out of the Business Park more effectively. The existing Davisville Road will not be moved under the plan. The new road configuration extends Gate Road, adds a rotary inside the park (at the urging of RIDOT) and constructs a new road connecting Gate Road and Commerce Park.
